FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION FOR 2010-2011 SCHOOL YEAR. Parents its time to apply now! All you need is last year's W-2's (2009) and your 2008 tax returns. Remember that in order to be eligible for FA, you must apply through FACTS. One application will allow you to apply for FA from CTK as well as through the Diocese's McMahon Parater Foundation. We are sug-

gesting that all Financial Aid applications be submitted by March 1st for appropriate processing.
